

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province

as of 08 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2025 at around 10:46 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Jungle Town, Brgy Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out at around 10:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain **Province** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱16,071.32** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱2,378.55** from **DSWD** and **₱13,692.77** from **Other Partners** (see Annex C).
