

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province

as of 08 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2025 at around 10:46 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Jungle Town, Brgy Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out at around 10:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱16,071.32** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱2,378.55** from **DSWD** and **₱13,692.77** from **Other Partners** (see Annex C).
