

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion I, Capoocan, Leyte

as of 22 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 May 2025 at around 8:39 AM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Poblacion I, Capoocan, Leyte. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 8:43 AM. One residential structure was completely destroyed, displacing a resident who has since sought temporary shelter with relatives.

One (1) family or **one (1) person** is affected in **Brgy. Poblacion I, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or one (1) person is temporarily staying with her relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion I, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,105.05** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family / person (see Annex D).
