

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pugol, Lamut, Ifugao as of 30 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 May 2025 at around 3PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Pugol, Lamut, Ifugao. The fire was declared out at around 3:40 PM. It is suspected to have been caused by an unattended firewood used for cooking. The fire completely destroyed a residential structure, displacing a male senior citizen, who was the sole occupant of the home. No casualties or injuries were reported.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) person is affected in **Brgy. Pugol, Lamut, Ifugao** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) person is temporarily staying in a makeshift hut and a family tent provided to him while the construction of his new house is ongoing (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pugol, Lamut, Ifugao** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱26,187.83** worth of assistance was provided to the affected resident; of which, **₱24,687.33** from **DSWD** and **₱1,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
