

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City as of 26 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 May 2025 at around 1:29 PM, a fire incident occurred at Buhuan St., San Antonio Valley 1, Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 4:00 PM. Due to the incident, 350 individuals were affected and caused damage to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office National Capital Region (FO NCR), is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Parañaque City, for any requests for resource augmentation to support the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **90 families** or **350 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **90 families** or **350 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **San Antonio Valley Covered Court** in **Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **59 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City** (see Annex C).
