

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion, Tanuan, Leyte** as of 26 May 2025, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 23 May 2025 at around 2:10 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion, Tanuan, Leyte, causing significant damage to several houses that resulted in the displacement of 49 individuals in the area. The fire was declared out at 4:47 AM.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VIII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tanuan, Leyte, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) and financial assistance (FA) to the affected individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **13 families** or **49 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion, Tanuan, Leyte** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **five (5) families** or **12 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion Gym in Tanuan, Leyte** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **eight (8) families** or **37 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **13 families** or **49 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion, Tanuan, Leyte** (see Annex F).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Santo Niño Poblacion, Tanuan, Leyte** (see Annex G).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱208,230.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex H).
