

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City

as of 06 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2025 at around 6:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 19, Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and successfully extinguished the fire at around 6:58 PM.

Several houses were destroyed, displacing numerous families and individuals. According to the investigation, the fire was caused by a circuit breaker failure, which led to a sudden explosion.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **25 families** or **115 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tambacan**, **Iligan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **115 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Candelario Luisma Gym** in **Brgy. Tambacan**, **Iligan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were damaged; of which, 13 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P154,645.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P142,270.00** from **DSWD** and **P12,375.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
