

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tib-o, Abuyog, Leyte

as of 14 May 2025, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

On 01 May 2025 at around 11:05 AM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Tib-o, Abuyog, Leyte. The firefighters of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) responded to the scene and extinguished the fire. The fire completely destroyed a residential house, resulting in the displacement of a family. No casualties or injuries were reported.
