

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City as of 07 May 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 12:35 PM, a fire incident occurred at Masuhud Drive, Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City.

A total of **42 families** or **148 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **42 families** or **148 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Tumaga Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **42 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱255,785.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
