

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City

as of 10 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 February 2025 at around 4:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 4:52 PM. Due to the incident, six (6) individuals were affected and caused damage to their house.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Baguio City, provided relief assistance to address the needs of the affected individuals.

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City (see Annex A).

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P4,791.60** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex C).
