I. Situation Overview

On 14 May 2025 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Zone 1 Poblacion, Dell Gallego, Camarines Sur.

A total of four (4) families or 20 persons are affected in Brgy. Zone 1 Fatima (Pob), Del Gallego, Camarines Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are four (4) families or 20 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Barangay Hall in Brgy. Zone 1 Fatima (Pob), Del Gallego, Camarines Sur (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Zone 1 Fatima (Pob), Del Gallego, Camarines Sur (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P35,735.84** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
