

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan

as of 27 May 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 09 May 2025 at around 3:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan that affected the livelihood of vendors and stall occupants.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **308 families** or **355 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion**, **Basista**, **Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **six** (6) **families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱183,500.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).
