

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat as of 07 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 May 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, caused by prevailing Easterlies, may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day, Brgy Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced a flash flood incident due to moderate to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.
