

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Monkeypox Cases in Tagudin, Ilocos Sur

as of 05 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 April 2025, one (1) confirmed case of monkeypox virus was confirmed in the municipality of Tagudin, llocos Sur. The family members and close contacts of the confirmed case are currently under 21-day home quarantine.

The quarantine has significant social and economic impacts, as it requires affected individuals and their families to temporarily suspend their daily activities. In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region I, has provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or 17 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Tagudin, Ilocos Sur (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}27,246.38\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}16,246.38\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}11,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex B).
