

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Red Tide Toxin in the Coastal Waters of Pangasinan

as of 23 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 April 2025, the Department of Agriculture (DA) - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) issued a local red tide warning for the coastal waters of the Municipalities of Anda and Bolinao, Pangasinan.

According to the Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) of the affected LGUs, the effects of red tide have impacted the livelihood and food security of the families / persons in the said areas.

A total of **251 families** or **1,156 persons** are affected in **14 barangays** in **Anda and Bolinao, Pangasinan** (see Table 1).
