

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Vehicular Incident in Brgy. Bantay, Boac, Marinduque as of 06 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2025 at around 5:39 AM, a vehicular incident occurred along the National Road in Brgy. Bantay, Boac, Marinduque, resulting in the deaths of six (6) passengers and injuries to several others.

Personnel from the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Bureau of Fire Protection, and the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) of the LGU of Boac, Marinduque promptly responded to the scene. All injured passengers were immediately transported to a nearby hospital for medical treatment.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **26 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bantay, Boac, Marinduque** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱270,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱110,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱160,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
