

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Civil Unrest in Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur as of 16 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2025 at around 12AM, a shooting incident transpired between an alleged private army group and political supporters in Brgy. Pandag and Lower D'Iag, Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur. The incident resulted in multiple casualties and displacement of 2,059 individuals.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur, immediately provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **485 families** or **2,059 persons** are affected in **Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **485 families** or **2,050 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱234,494.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
