

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region

as of 22 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 May 2025 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions might have led to possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms affecting the Davao Region.

Localized flooding incidents were reported particularly in Panabo City, Davao del Norte, and Maragusan, Davao de Oro. The latter occurred due to the downstream overflow of Tagbibinta Falls. No casualties have been reported but minor property damages have been recorded.

A total of **503 families** or **2,114 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in the **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

- ₱154.14 million worth of other FNIs available at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
