

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

as of 22 May 2025, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

On 15 March 2025 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. Several houses were completely destroyed, and many residents were displaced.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **26 families** or **108 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 21 families or 89 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Covered Court in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **12 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex E).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are **24 families** or **101 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. 1 (Pob.)**, **San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex F).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **25** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex G).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$32,574.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$288,340.00 from \$\mathbb{D}\$SWD; \$\mathbb{P}\$53,914.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU); and \$\mathbb{P}\$190,320.00 from Other Partners (see Annex H).
