

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City as of 23 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 May 2025 at around 2:35 PM, a fire broke out at 136 Cardena De Amor St., Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:20 PM. Several residential houses were completely destroyed, displacing numerous families who were accommodated in an evacuation center in the area. No casualties were reported.

A total of **120 families** or **420 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **120 families** or **420 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
