

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City

as of 09 May 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 28 April 2025 at around 3:13 AM, a fire incident occurred at Estrada St., and Onyx St., in Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:02 AM. Due to the incident, 600 individuals were affected, significantly damaging their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City, immediately provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **173 families** or **600 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **173 families** or **600 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in the tents established along **Onyx Street** in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱119,197.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
