

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 81, Caloocan City as of 16 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 May 2025 at around 4:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at B. Natividad St., Brgy. 81, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 10:17 PM. Due to the incident, 1,080 individuals were affected and caused damage to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), is continuously coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Caloocan City for updates and request for relief augmentation support.

A total of **216 families** or **1,080 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 81, Caloocan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **216 families** or **1,080 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. 81, Caloocan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **80 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 81, Caloocan City** (see Annex C).
