

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City as of 01 June 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 30 May 2025, a fire broke out in Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the incident at around 9:50 AM and had the fire extinguished by 11:41 AM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing 382 individuals in the area.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lapu-Lapu City for any updates and requests for resource augmentation to support the affected individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **194 families** or **382 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **194 families** or **382 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Gym in Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City** (see Annex C).
