

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. E. Rodriguez, Sr., Quezon City as of 08 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 11:56 AM, a fire incident occurred at 138-139 Ermin Garcia St., Brgy. E. Rodriguez, Sr., Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 1:44 PM. No casualties were recorded during the incident.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Quezon City, immediately provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **366 families** or **1,191 persons** are affected in **Brgy. E. Rodriguez, Sr., Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **366 families** or **1,191 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. E. Rodriguez, Sr., Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **161 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. E. Rodriguez, Sr., Quezon City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,308,394.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
