

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City as of 07 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2025 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 AM. Due to the incident, 76 individuals were affected resulting in significant damages to their houses.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) X, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, for any relief augmentation support.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **18 families** or **74 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **26 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Nazareth Health Center** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **19 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **10 families** or **45 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱197,100.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱159,300.00** from **DSWD** and **₱37,800.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
