I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 12:35 PM, a fire incident occurred at Masahud Drive, Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City.

A total of **43 families** or **148 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **43 families** or **148 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Tumaga Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **43 houses** were damaged; of which, **42** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tumaga, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱255,785.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
