

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City as of 26 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 11:55 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City causing significant damages to several houses that resulted in the displacement of 600 individuals in the area.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of General Santos City, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) to support the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **242 families** or **600 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There were **120 families** or **258 persons** who sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Labangal Gymnasium** in **General Santos City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There were **122 families** or **342 persons** who temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There were **242 families** or **600 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **242 houses** were damaged; of which, **234** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,564,284.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,539,284.00** from **DSWD** and **₱25,000.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex H).
