

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental as of 22 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2025 at around 8PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental. The fire damaged several residential houses, displacing numerous families and individuals.

The affected families and individuals were accommodated in an evacuation center. Most of them remain in the evacuation center, while others have returned home after building makeshift houses.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **28 families** or **117 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **18 families** or **77 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Philippine Normal University** in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **24 houses** were damaged; of which, **23** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱309,837.76** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱234,237.76** from **DSWD** and **₱75,600.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
