

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City as of 08 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Rawis St., Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared under control at 7:09 AM.

A total of **154 families** or **616 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **154 families** or **616 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay 118 Covered Court** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **58 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱106,106.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).


