

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City as of 08 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:56 AM, a fire incident occurred at Road 10, Moriones St., Brgy 123, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:09 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **918 families** or **2,712 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **918 families** or **2,712 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the modular tents established along **Moriones Street** in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **343 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
