

DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Structural Vulnerabilities of the San Juanico Bridge

as of 24 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2025, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) imposed a temporary maximum gross vehicle weight limit of three (3) metric tons on all vehicles crossing the San Juanico Bridge, which connects the provinces of Leyte and Samar. This measure is being implemented due to identified structural vulnerabilities in the bridge.

The restriction on the types of vehicles allowed to cross the San Juanico bridge may impact economic activities, delay the delivery of essential services and commodities, and disrupt daily operations, affecting many people who depend on this crucial route.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **953 families** or **1,275 persons** are affected in **Regions V** and **VIII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 11 families or 58 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Matnog Public Auditorium in Matnog, Sorsogon (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P503,286.10** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families and individuals (see Annex E).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱324.45 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) available at the DSWD Central Office.
- 6 million available at DSWD FOs V and VIII.
- ₱40.78 million available in other FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the Structural Vulnerabilities of the San Juanico Bridge through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 772,622 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 402,461 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 370,161 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 354.333 FFPs available at DSWD FOs V and VIII.
- 1,828,241 FFPs are available in other FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the Structural Vulnerabilities of the San Juanico Bridge through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱877.63 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

22 May 2025	DSWD FO VIII facilitated the distribution of FNIs to the families and individuals stranded in Basey and Sta. Rita, Samar, and Tacloban City.
21 May 2025	DSWD FO VIII facilitated the distribution of FNIs to the families and individuals stranded in Sta. Rita, Samar and Tacloban City, Leyte and San Antonio, Basey, Samar.
20 May 2025	 DSWD FO VIII facilitated the distribution of FFPs to the families and individuals stranded in Basey and Sta. Rita, Samar and Tacloban City Leyte.

23 May 2025	 DSWD FO V closely coordinates with the LGUs accommodating the stranded families and individuals, and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for augmentation.

FO VIII

DATE	ACTIVITIES
22 May 2025	 DSWD FO VIII closely coordinated with the LGUs accommodating the stranded families and individuals, and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. DSWD FO VIII deployed its Mobile Command Center to monitor and gather updates on the stranded families and individuals. DSWD FO VIII, in coordination with the Municipal Action Team (MAT) in Sta. Rita, Samar continuously administer the profiling and validation of the stranded families and individuals through the use of Family Access Card in Emergencies and Disasters (FACED).
22 May 2025	DSWD FO VIII referred the stranded families and individuals to the Crisis Intervention Section for further assessment and provision of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS).
