I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2025 at around 7:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City.

Outside Evacuation Center One (1) person temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱10,790.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected person; of which, ₱6,500.00 from DSWD and ₱4,290.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
