

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Oñate de Leon, Mandurriao, Iloilo City 27 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 May 2025 at around 11:41 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Oñate de Leon, Mandurriao, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 12:17 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **Seven (7) families** or **21 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Oñate de Leon, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **Seven (7) families** or **21 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives in **Brgy. Oñate de Leon, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Oñate de Leon, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱79,007.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱49,154.00** from **DSWD** and **₱29,853.50** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
