

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Nicolas III, City of Bacoor, Cavite

13 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 April 2025 at around 3:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Latero, Brgy. San Nicolas III, City of Bacoor, Cavite. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and volunteer fire brigades responded to the scene and successfully extinguished the fire at around 5:11 AM. No casualties were recorded during the incident.

As a result of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC)'s Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis, the area was placed under a State of Calamity on 28 April 2025 which triggered the mobilization of resources to address the needs of the affected population.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **83 families** or **367 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Nicolas III, City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **74 families** or **319 persons** sought temporary shelter in **San Nicolas III Covered Court** in **Brgy. San Nicolas III, City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **48 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **83 families** or **367 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Nicolas III, City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,641,140.68** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱715,196.06** from **DSWD** and **₱1,925,944.62** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
