

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental

05 June 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2025 at around 5:30 AM, an encounter happened between the elements of the 47th, 15th and 11th Infantry Battalions under the 302<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade of the Philippine Army and the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the hinterland part of Purok Maghirupay, Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental.
