

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental

05 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2025 at around 5:30 AM, an encounter happened between the elements of the 47th, 15th and 11th Infantry Battalions under the 302nd Infantry Brigade of the Philippine Army and the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the hinterland part of Purok Maghirupay, Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental.
