

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Kabugao, Apayao

25 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 April to 11 April 2025, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Maragat and Brgy. Dagara in the Municipality of Kabugao, Apayao between the Philippine Army's 98th Infantry (MASINAG) Battalion and the 20 members of the Communist Terrorists Group (CTG) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area. Due to the incident, 1,330 individuals were affected

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office Cordillera Administrative Region (FO CAR), in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Kabugao, Apayao, immediately provided relief assistance to address the needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **335 families** or **1,330 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Kabugao**, **Apayao** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱531,209.50 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
