

## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Antipolo, Asipulo, Ifugao**

18 May 2025, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 21 April 2025 at around 7:53 AM, a fire incident occurred at Fort Sitio Bahag, Brgy. Antipolo, Asipulo, Ifugao. The fire was declared out at around 8:22 AM. Due to the incident, five (5) individuals were affected and caused damage to their house.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Asipulo, Ifugao, provided Food and Non-Food Items (FNIs) to the affected individuals.

**One (1) family or five (5) persons** were affected in **Brgy. Antipolo, Asipulo, Ifugao** (see Annex A).

### **III. Damaged Houses**

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Antipolo, Asipulo, Ifugao** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱21,052.25** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family, of which **₱12,164.25** from **DSWD** and **₱8,888.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex C).
