

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province

15 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2025 at around 10:46 AM, a fire broke out at Sitio Jungle Town, Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province. It was declared a fire out at around 10:55 AM. Despite the damage sustained by the residential structure, the affected family chose to stay after the incident to begin cleaning up and making repairs immediately.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or four (4) persons were affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P21,071.32** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **P7,378.55** from **DSWD** and **P13,692.77** from **other Partners** (see Annex C).
