

## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province**

15 June 2025, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 16 April 2025 at around 10:46 AM, a fire broke out at Sitio Jungle Town, Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province. It was declared a fire out at around 10:55 AM. Despite the damage sustained by the residential structure, the affected family chose to stay after the incident to begin cleaning up and making repairs immediately.

**One (1) family or four (4) persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province** (see Annex A).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱21,071.32** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱7,378.55** from **DSWD** and **₱13,692.77** from **other Partners** (see Annex C).
