

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental

07 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2025 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Tisay, Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **28 families** or **117 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **117 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Philippine Normal University and Dr. Vicente F. Gustilo Memorial National High School** in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **24 houses** were damaged; of which, **23** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion Zone 1, Cadiz City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱329,752.96** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱254,152.96** from **DSWD** and **₱75,600.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F)
