

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Monkeypox Cases in Tagudin, Ilocos Sur

12 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 April 2025, one (1) confirmed case of the monkeypox virus was reported in the municipality of Tagudin, Ilocos Sur. The family members and close contacts of the confirmed case underwent a 21-day home quarantine.

The quarantine had significant social and economic impacts, requiring affected individuals and their families to temporarily suspend their daily activities. In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region I, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families or 17 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Tagudin, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).
