

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Red Tide Toxin in the Coastal Waters of Pangasinan

22 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 April 2025, the Department of Agriculture (DA) - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) issued a local red tide warning for the coastal waters of the Municipalities of Anda and Bolinao, Pangasinan.

According to the Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) of the affected LGUs, the effects of red tide have impacted the livelihood and food security of the families / persons in the said areas.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **301 families** or **1,406 persons** were affected in **15 barangays** in **Anda** and **Bolinao**, **Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱191,271.70** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
