

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clustering of Cholera Cases in Brgy. Lemsnolon, T'boli, South Cotabato

as of 24 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2025, the Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) of Lemsnolon declared a State of Emergency in response to a surge in cholera cases in Brgy. Lemsnolon, T'boli, South Cotabato. The declaration was made through Sangguniang Barangay Resolution No. 11, Series of 2025.

Of the 131 cholera cases reported, only three (3) remain active as of the latest update.

A total of **68 families** or **131 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lemsnolon, T'boli, South Cotabato** (see Table 1).
