

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Sultan Kudarat as of 06 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 03 June 2025 at around 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains. On the same day at around 10PM, several barangays in Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat experienced flash floods due to heavy rainfall caused by ITCZ.

On 04 June 2025 at around 8:27 PM, Brgy. Poblacion, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat experienced flooding due to heavy continuous rains brought by the ITCZ.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, has been actively coordinating with the Local Government Units (LGUs) in the affected areas of Sultan Kudarat to assess the situation and provide immediate assistance to the affected families and individuals.
