

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental

as of 14 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 12 June 2025 at around 4:00 PM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms. These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On 13 June 2025 at around 3:00 AM, several barangays in Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental experienced flash floods and landslides due to intense rains brought by localized thunderstorms.
