

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City

as of 05 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2025 at around 12:01 PM, a fire broke out at Globo De Oro St., Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the incident and had the fire extinguished by 6:25 PM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area. No casualties were reported.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **327 families** or **1,158 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **327 families** or **1,158 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at a campsite along the street of Brgy. 384 in **Quiapo**, **Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 384**, **Quiapo**, **Manila City** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 718,689 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 427,481 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 291,208 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 52,182 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱149.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

05 June 2025	 DSWD FO NCR closely coordinated with the BFP and LGU of Manila City, through the Manila Department of Social Welfare (MDSW), to gather further information regarding the incident. DSWD FO NCR ensures availability of relief resources once the LGU requests for augmentation.
