

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City as of 05 June 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2025 at around 12:01 PM, a fire broke out at Globo De Oro St., Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the incident and had the fire extinguished by 6:25 PM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area. No casualties were reported.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **327 families** or **1,158 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **327 families** or **1,158 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at a campsite along the street of Brgy. 384 in **Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
