

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Baga-uma, Aroroy, Masbate

as of 13 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 June 2025 at around 5:40 PM, a fire broke out at Purok 3, Inopia St., Brgy. Baga-uma, Aroroy, Masbate. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 6:20 PM. A residential building was completely destroyed, displacing several residents who lived in the building.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 16 persons are affected in Brgy. Baga-uma, Aroroy, Masbate (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Baga-uma, Aroroy, Masbate (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P39,984.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
