

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Hibunawan, Baybay City, Leyte as of 30 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2025 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Hibunawan, Baybay City, Leyte. The incident resulted in the displacement of families and damage to residential houses.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **four (4) families** or **18 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Hibunawan, Baybay City, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **18 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Hibunawan, Baybay City, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱32,788.40** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
